Booking Fees

To assist with planning the Vacation Care program, and the ratio of children to staff members required to run it, it has become necessary to implement a booking fee set by the GGOSH committee at \$20 per family. The fee will be fully refunded (or set against your GGOSH fees) at the end of each Vacation Care except where children have been booked into Vacation Care, but have not attended on the day.

Late Cancellation at any time or simply not attending after booking a place will incur a fee of \$10 per child per day. This fee is required to offset the cost incurred by "No Shows" – since staffing and activities are organised and costed to meet the expected number of children. The Vacation Care program is becoming increasingly popular, so early bookings are advisable to ensure a place in the program.

Snack time will be around 3:30pm to 4:00pm each afternoon, however on home days children may eat and drink at their own leisure throughout the day.

Excursions

On excursion days please ensure that your child is wearing comfortable walking shoes and has a suitable backpack/bag to carry their recess, lunch, drinks etc.

Unless otherwise stated in the program, spending money during excursions is allowable at parent's discretion. Staff are happy to supervise and guide children in spending their money. If requested, staff are able to retain children's spending money in a safe place until the excursion venue is reached.

Unless otherwise stated in the program, excursion days are full day events, with return times to GGOSH being at 5:00pm.

Unless otherwise stated in the program, travel to and from excursion venues will be via public transport.

In the event of a delay in the return time to GGOSH (after 5:00pm) on excursion days, staff will endeavour to notify parents via a phone call. Alternatively a notice will be placed on the GGOSH building entrance door to advise parents of the relevant details. Whilst every effort is made to adhere to the scheduled times stated on the program, some flexibility due to unforeseen circumstances is advised.

Please note that on excursion days children are required to be at Vacation Care prior to 8:30am.
