

Uniform policy

Rationale

The purpose of a policy on school uniform is to provide for parents and students, a clear and common understanding of what is required in the wearing of a school uniform.

The Golden Grove Lutheran school community regards the uniform as an important aspect of the school image, general philosophy and condition of enrolment. The uniform was the result of collaboration between the School Council, staff, students and the parent community. Students are expected to wear the uniform correctly, with pride and self-respect. This is set out in the Uniform Handbook.

A consistent uniform worn by all students and kept to a minimal cost, helps students feel part of the community and enables them to show pride and respect towards their school. A high standard of dress and grooming is essential to reflect the personal standards required of students at Golden Grove Lutheran Primary School.

Through the School Council, the P. & F. will be invited to consider requests for changes to uniform. Any changes to the uniform shall be accompanied by a minimum two-year phase in period, with no further changes for a minimum of three years.

Policy Statement

A school uniform encourages a sense of belonging and provides a visible identity with the Golden Grove Lutheran school community and all students are expected to wear their uniform correctly with pride every day.

Aims

That students will:

- correctly wear the school uniform to school every day as described in the Uniform Handbook.

Parents are expected to:

- support the school in the matter of correct uniform as described in the Uniform Handbook.

Golden Grove Lutheran Primary School staff will:

- expect the students to wear the correct uniform at all times and enforce the wearing of the uniform as described in the Uniform Handbook.

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
