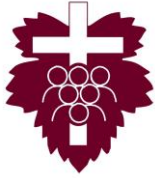

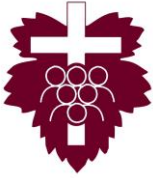

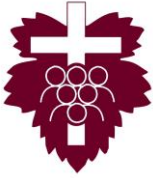

The Girl Power workshop will happen once the COVID19 restrictions ease. • Parent Information Night Presentations Due to COVID19 restrictions currently we can't provide these – it is likely that we won't be able to have any of these nights this year. • Update – Student Crossing (School Driveway) – Car park/ Kiss and Drop (Shane)- Shane advised that this is on Kuno's long list of big jobs – he is currently working on the Greenroom and new outdoor area – but it will be done soon. Discussion regarding Kiss and Drop and rules and procedures to be in the next school newsletter now that a lot more people are using Kiss and Drop due to COVID19 and parents recommended not to be on school grounds if possible.

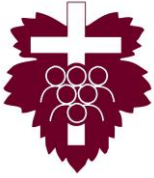
