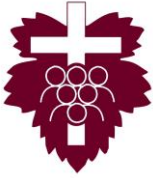

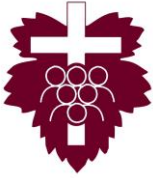

5	<p><b>Principal's Report</b> – As Shane was absent from the meeting Tim gave an update on his</p>

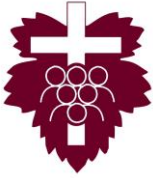

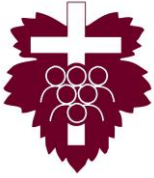
