Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Thank you for your continued support and for the continued way in which you have been able to look after each other with a strong community spirit.

The government has provided an update in relation to the restrictions in place for schools. We continue to be thankful for the patience and understanding of all of our families being able to follow these to ensure our shared health and wellbeing going forward:

- We continue to be advised to limit the number of visitors that we have on site where possible to staff, students and essential services only, and that parent-teacher meetings, if required, should occur by phone or similar virtual means of communication.
- Please support us by not entering classrooms or the front office and avoid coming into the school yard if possible. If you do have an urgent reason to come into the front office, please wear a face mask and use the QR code and the hand sanitiser provided.
- If you are able to use Kiss and Drop in the mornings and afternoons, it would be much appreciated.
- Foundation families are able to drop their children off at the classroom door and our staff will support their safe entry into the classroom. Foundation families choosing to drop their children off in this way should ensure social distancing from other parents and staff and wear a mask.
- The school canteen continues to operate as normal on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, with the regular menu available via the Qkr! app.
- We are now able to hold whole school Assemblies and Chapels, however we are still waiting for a further update on the current restrictions on density requirements and physical distancing as they relate to the use of the Worship Centre. We hope that a limited number of parents may be able to preregister for Assembly and Chapel as of next week (Week 4) and will let you know as soon as we have more information in this area.
- The uniform shop will be open by appointment. Appointments can be made by copying the code **f4t9u** and pasting it into

<https://www.schoolinterviews.com.au/>. We can arrange ordering over the phone for families who need items urgently.

- After school basketball and netball training will resume this week. We ask that parents enter for pick up only at the end of training via the gate on Richardson Drive to collect students from outside the courts on the path next to the oval.
- We look forward to holding a P & F Meeting at school next Monday evening (Monday 9 August), commencing at 7.00 pm. Due to the government guidelines and density requirements in place for schools at the moment, we ask that families [please preregister via the school website](#) in the same way as we do for Chapels and Assemblies, and wear a mask if planning to attend the meeting.

It remains essential that staff, students, and others do not come on to the school site if they are unwell and that they get tested for COVID-19 if they have any of the following symptoms, even if mild:

- fever or chills
- cough
- sore throat
- runny nose
- shortness of breath
- loss of taste or smell
- diarrhoea and vomiting.
