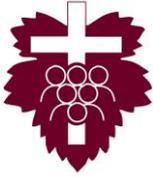

1	<p>Upcoming Events:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <p>Disco – 20th August</p> <p>Discussion around how comfortable we are with running the event in light of recent Covid restrictions. Decision to go ahead as planned and review as needed given that things can change at any time, even if we were to postpone, we might find ourselves in the same situation. With the split of two groups it can still work within capacity restrictions. Just need to have not too many adults congregating outside, and unfortunately won't have an area for parents to stay like we have done in previous years. May just have to be a drop and go. Needing volunteers – company recommending 6-8 helpers. We can start off with this, if restrictions ease, we can revisit having more people being able to stay.</p> <p>Snuggies & Uggies Bingo – 28th August</p> <p>Again, discussion around whether to move forward with this date, exec agreed to keep the date for the same reasons. Social distancing can be controlled if necessary with the set-up of the trestle tables/seating. We will look at what is happening with restrictions over the next week and make a definitive decision on whether to forge ahead in a week's time. Michelle said everything is included with previous price quoted except for the prizes. The presenter would need to be on site an hour before to setup. Evening to start at 7pm. An hour of Bingo, a break, and then the next session, etc.</p> <p>MOT – 18th August</p> <p>This breakfast could be pushed out the 25th if restrictions go backwards. Also the possibility to keep it just to staff and students only as we did last year when restrictions were in place. Last year they did a sausage sizzle at recess, and there were no complaints around this; the school community seemed to understand and were accepting. Decision to have pancakes again, the kids loved it and easy to preserve if the date does need to be moved. Make a definitive decision closer to the date; keep it as the 18th August for now.</p> <p>Sports Day Term 3</p> <p>To be held on the 9th September – coinciding with 'R U OK' day, wellbeing and mental health focus in the morning, 'fun' sports day in the afternoon. Yellow theme. Help will be needed with volunteers on the day.</p> <p>Special Persons Afternoon (SPA)</p> <p>Booked in for the 17th September, again a 'wait and see' with our friend COVID.</p>



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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Church Fete Michelle will have a phone conversation with Leslie regarding the churches plan for entertainment. Michelle has had two quotes from the company that provided amusements for our picnic earlier in the year - \$2000 for what they provided last time, \$1700 if they take one of the amusements out. Need to check with church as to what their thoughts are and will raise this at our next scheduled P&F meeting to make a decision on which way to go. Kylie raised the question do we charge for entertainment? Will said he doesn't think so – they will be running school tours that day and it is a good buy in, but recommended confirming this with the church. If it were to be a gold coin donation, does it come back to us – or go to the church? Decision is that this was our donation towards the event and to the church. • Book Week How can P&F be involved? Will suggested perhaps purchasing books to be gifted to the children. To be discussed further at next meeting. • Christmas 2021 Discussion will be carried over to the agenda for the next meeting, talks around what our end of term event/s will look like, and whether we run an activity similar to what we provided at Easter (Will is happy for this to happen as there was a lot of positive feedback from Easter).
